Feedback: Capacity is the maximum amount that a container can hold, especially liquid. By filling the jug with small cups, you are determining how much the jug can hold.

Correct Option: B) Kilograms

Feedback: Kilograms (kg) are a standard unit for measuring the mass or weight of relatively heavy objects like a school bag full of books. Centimetres and metres measure length, and litres measure liquid capacity.

A) Their speeds

Correct Option: D) Their weights

Feedback: The terms 'heavy' and 'light' are used to describe the weight or mass of an object.

Question 5 A gardener uses a can that holds 1 litre of water to water each plant. If he has 8 plants. How many litres of water will he need?

- A) 5
- B) 3
- C) 7
- D) 8

Correct Option: D) 8

Feedback: This is a simple multiplication problem. You need 1 litre for each of the 8 plants. Calculation: 1liter x 8 plants = 8 liters.

Question 6 On a see-saw, Which side will go down?

- A) The side with a child carrying a water bottle
- B) The side with a child carrying a heavy school bag
- C) The side with a child carrying a pencil
- D) Both sides will stay balanced

Correct Option: B) The side with a child carrying a heavy school bag.

Feedback: A see-saw is a lever balanced by weight (mass). The side with the most weight will go down. A heavy school bag weighs significantly more than a water bottle or a pencil.

Question 7 A bottle can hold 2 litres of water. A jug can hold 5 litres of water. If you pour two full bottles of water into the jug, how much more water can the jug hold?

- A) 1 litre
- B) 2 litres
- C) 3 litres
- D) 4 litres

Correct Option: A) 1 liter

Feedback: Water poured into the jug: 2 bottles of 2 litres each = 4 litres, water capacity is 5 litres.

Remaining capacity: $5 - 4 = 1$ litre

Question 8 Standard bathtub can hold about 150 of which unit of liquid?

- A) Kilograms
- B) Millilitres
- C) Grams
- D) Litres

Correct Option: D) Litres

Feedback: A bathtub holds a large volume of water, making Litres (L) the appropriate unit.

Question 9 Ramu is holding 3 lunchboxes in the left hand and a pencil box in the right hand. Which hand needs more effort to hold the object?

- A) Left hand
- B) Right hand
- C) Both hands need equal effort
- D) None of these

Correct Option: A) Left hand

Feedback: The effort needed to hold an object depends on its weight (mass). Since 3 lunch boxes will weigh much more than a single, light pencil box, the left hand will need to exert more effort.

Question 10 Observe the picture. How many bowls will be required to fill the bucket?



(Based on the visual relationships in the image: 2 bowls = 1 small glass; 2 small glasses = 1 jug; 2 jugs = 1 bucket.)

- A) 11
- B) 12
- C) 13
- D) 14

Correct Option: B) 12

Convert Glasses to Bowls: Since 1 Glass = 2 Bowls, then 6 Glasses = $6 \times 2 = 12$ Bowls. Therefore, the bucket requires 12 bowls to be filled.
