Answer: (C) 240

Feedback: $12 \times 20 = (10 \times 20) + (2 \times 20) = 200 + 40 = 240$

3. If 324 children need to be seated and each coach holds 14, how many full coaches are needed?

- (A) 22
- (B) 23
- (C) 24
- (D) 25

Answer: (B) 23

Feedback: $324 \div 14 = 23$ coaches with 2 children left over.

4. What is the value of 50×60 ?

- (A) 3000
- (B) 2500

Answer: (A) 3000

Feedback: $50 \times 60 = 5 \times 6 \times 100 = 30 \times 100 = 3000$

5. How many people can be seated in 12 buses if each bus holds 20 people?

- (A) 200

- (D) 250

Answer: (C) 240

Feedback: $12 \times 20 = 240$

6. What is 70×80 ?

- (A) 5200
- (B) 5600
- (C) 6000

Answer: (B) 5600

Feedback: $70 \times 80 = 7 \times 8 \times 100 = 56 \times 100 = 5600$

7. How many seats are there on a double-decker bus with 15 seats on the lower and 10 on the upper deck?

- (A) 20
- (B) 25
- (C) 30
- (D) 35

Answer: (B) 25

Feedback: $15 + 10 = 25$ total seats

8. If a coach carries 72 passengers and the train has 24 coaches, how many people can travel?

- (A) 1728
- (B) 1800
- (C) 1680
- (D) 1740

Answer: (A) 1728

Feedback: $72 \times 24 = 1728$

9. What is the product of 64×152 ?

- (A) 9728
- (B) 9548

Answer: (A) 9728

Feedback: Computed by splitting: $60 \times 100 + 60 \times 50 + 60 \times 2 + 4 \times 100 + 4 \times 50 + 4 \times 2 = 9728$

10. How many boats are needed for 960 participants if each boat holds 64 people?

- (A) 14
- (B) 15
- (C) 16
- (D) 13

Answer: (B) 15

Feedback: $960 \div 64 = 15$

Answer: c) It is waterproof and light

****Feedback**** Plastic does not absorb water and is easy to carry because it is lightweight.

Answer: c) Wood

****Feedback**** Wood is a natural material that can break down in nature and does not harm the environment as much as plastic or Styrofoam.

- b) Refuse, Reduce, Reuse, Repurpose, Recycle

Answer: b) Old newspapers

****Feedback**** Newspapers are made of paper, so they can be broken down and made into fresh paper products.

Answer: c) People who are blind or have low vision
