Answer: C) Multiply rows and patches

Feedback: 5×10 gives the total patches quickly.

C) They cover the floor without gaps

D) They are lighter

Answer: C) They cover the floor without gaps

Feedback: Squares and rectangles fit perfectly and cover the surface fully.

Q4.Ravi wants to put a rope around a rectangular garden that is 10 m long and 5 m wide.

How much rope is needed to go once around the garden?

A) 30 m

B) 40 m

C) 50 m

D) 60 m

Answer: A) 30 m

Feedback: Perimeter = $2 \times (\text{length} + \text{breadth}) = 2 \times (10 + 5) = 30 \text{ m}$.

Q5.Meena wants to paint the floor of her room, not the walls.

Which measurement does she need to know?

A) Height of the room

B) Perimeter of the room

C) Area of the room

D) Length of the room only

Answer: C) Area of the room

Feedback: Painting the floor depends on how much surface area is covered.

Q6.Jaya's kitchen floor is 5 m long and 3 m wide. She wanted to buy a tile of size 1m long and 50 cm wide how many tiles she needs to buy for her kitchen?

A) 8

B) 15

C) 16

D) 30

Answer: D) 30

Feedback: She needs 2 tiles for 1 square meter area, and area of the kitchen is $5 \times 3 = 15$ square meter therefore required number of tiles = $15 \times 2 = 30$ tiles.

Q7.Which activity is the best measured in seconds?

C) Clapping hands once

Answer: C) Clapping hands once

Feedback: Very short actions are measured in seconds.

Q8.If a runner takes 30 seconds to complete one round, how long will he take for 4 rounds?

A) 60 seconds

C) 120 seconds

D) 150 seconds

Answer: C) 120 seconds

Feedback: $30 \times 4 = 120$ seconds.

Q9.The school assembly starts at 8:20 a.m. and lasts for 25 minutes.

At what time does it end?

A) 8:35 a.m.

B) 8:40 a.m.

C) 8:45 a.m.

D) 9:00 a.m.

Answer: C) 8:45 a.m.

Feedback: $8:20 + 25$ minutes = 8:45 a.m.

Q10.A train leaves at 6:10 a.m. and reaches at 7:25 a.m.

How long is the journey?

A) 1 hour

B) 1 hour 15 minutes

C) 1 hour 30 minutes

D) 2 hours

Answer: B) 1 hour 15 minutes

Feedback: From 6:10 to 7:25 is 1 hour 15 minutes.

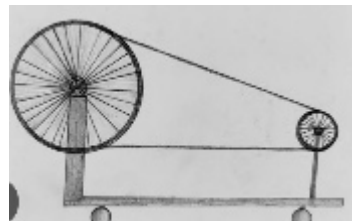
