Answer: 180 L

Feedback: $12 \times 15 = 180$ litres.

Answer: 15

Feedback: The pattern increases by 3 each row, $3 \times 5 = 15$ triangles.

Answer: 64

Feedback: Each term doubles; $32 \times 2 = 64$.

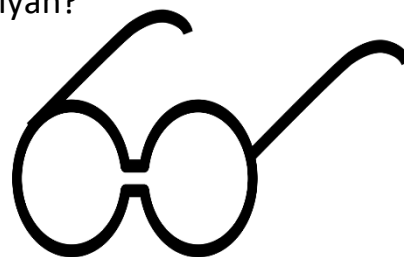
Answer: C) Gujarat
