Q.7- Which is the coldest place in India?

Correct responses- Drass-1879 / 5072 (37%)

Explanation –

A lonely town in the infamous Kargil district of Jammu and Kashmir, Dras is popularly known as 'the gateway to Ladakh'. It is known to be the coldest place in India and is recognized as the second coldest inhabited place in the world.

Q.8- Which of the following causes rainfall in West Bengal during the hot weather season? <u>Correct responses-</u> Kal Baishakhi 1985 / 5072 (39.13%)

Explanation -

The rising temperature in the summer results in low pressure troughs and attracts cyclonic and North West winds which result in rainfall along with thunderstorms in the months of April and May. These are known as Kal Baisakhi or nor-westers. During this time Odisha, West Bengal, Assam, Bihar, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, Bangladesh and North-Eastern states of India are affected by violent thunderstorms.

Q.1- What was the slogan coined by Hitler when he followed his aggressive foreign policy? –

Correct responses-One people, One Empire and one leader_3630 / 5072 (71.6%)

Explanation –

One people, one empire, and one leader was the slogan coined by Hitler when he followed his aggressive foreign policy.

Q.2- What was the thinking of Nazi Germany about women?-

Correct responses -All the above 2683 / 5072 (52.9%)

Explanation –

German nazi thought that Girls had to maintain the purity of the race and teach their children Nazi values, their role was to be mothers who had to be bearers of the Aryan culture and race, and The fight for equality between men and women was wrong.

Q.3- Who wrote 'Mein Kampf'? -

Correct responses-Adolf Hitler 3592 / 5072 (70.8%)

Explanation –

Mein Kampf, (German: "My Struggle") political manifesto written by Adolf Hitler. It was his only complete book, and the work became the bible of National Socialism (Nazism) in Germany's Third Reich. It was published in two volumes in 1925 and 1927, and an abridged edition appeared in 1930. By 1939 it had sold 5,200,000 copies and had been translated into 11 languages.

Q.4- In what ways did the First World War leave a deep imprint on European society and polity? –

Correct responses -All of the above2654 / 5072 (52.3%)

Explanation –

The impact of the war on the European Society was devastating. It affected the economic, social and political fabric of Europe. The soldiers were placed above the civilians. Politicians and publicists emphasised on the need for men to be aggressive, strong and masculine

The climate of any particular place is influenced by a host of interacting factors. These include latitude, elevation, nearby water, ocean currents, topography, vegetation, and prevailing winds.

Q.9- Which one of the following terms is used for the state of atmosphere over an area at any point of time?

Correct responses -Weather 2568 / 5072 (50.6%)
