On 30 January 1933, President Hindenburg offered the Chancellorship, the highest position in the cabinet of ministers, to Hitler. He pulled out of the League of Nations in 1933, reoccupied the Rhineland in 1936.

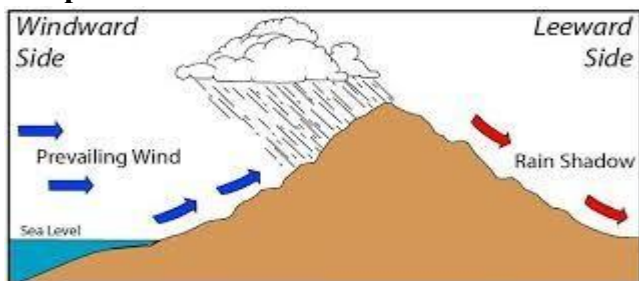
**What is the reason for this weather condition?**
