Q.1- Which river is called the Dihang when it enters India in Arunachal Pradesh?

**Ans-** (b) The Brahmaputra

### **Explanation-**

The Brahmaputra originates from the Chemayundung glacier near Manasarover lake in Tibet. In Arunachal Pradesh, Brahmaputra is known by the name Dihang. Brahmaputra enters India through the west of Sadiya town in Arunachal Pradesh.

### **Explanation-**

The Narmada, Periyar and Tapi are the only long rivers, which flow west and make estuaries. An Estuary is a partly enclosed coastal body of water with one or more rivers or streams flowing into it, and with a free connection to the open sea. Only West following rivers of India forms Estuary.
