Explanation: Cone, Cylinder, Sphere can roll due to curved surfaces. Cube has flat faces and sharp edges; it cannot roll smoothly.

- D) Cylinder

Answer: C) Cone

Explanation: Cone has 1 curved face, 1 flat circular face, 1 edge between flat and curved face, and 1 vertex at the tip.

4. Which figure will you get by folding a net of a cube?

- B) 6 Rectangle face
- C) Box with 6 square faces
- D) 8 Cylinder

Answer: C) Box with 6 square faces

Explanation: A cube net has 6 squares. When folded, it forms a 3D cube, also known as a box with 6 square faces.

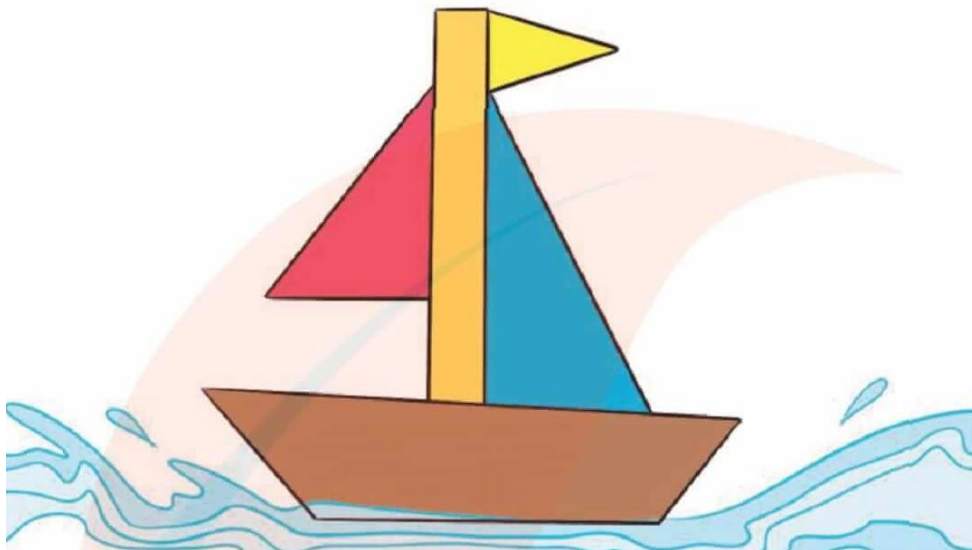
5. Riya uses 12 matchsticks to form squares. If each square requires 4 matchsticks, how many squares can she make, and how many matchsticks will remain?

Explanation: Each square uses 4 matchsticks. With 12 matchsticks, Riya can make $12 \div 4 = 3$ squares. Since $3 \times 4 = 12$, no matchsticks remain.

Answer: B) 17 corners

Explanation: Total corners = 4 (Trapezium) + 3 (Flag) + 3 (Red sail) + 3 (Blue sail) + 4 (Mast) = 17 corners

7. Priya played a game where she had to identify a shape with 3 sides and 3 corners. Which shape is it?

- A) Circle
- B) Triangle
- C) Square
- D) Rectangle

Answer: B) Triangle

Explanation: A triangle is a shape with exactly three sides and three corners (vertices).

8. A juggler was tossing rings shaped like circles. How many sides does a circle have?

- A) 0

Answer: A) 0

Explanation: A circle is a round in shape with no sides or corners.

9. Children created a pattern with shapes on a display board:

Correct Answer: C) Triangle
