Subject:- Implementation of Skill Modules/Subject for Classes VI to XI from the Academic Year, 2024-25 in all KVs-reg.

Madam/Sir,

Para 16.4 of NEP 2020 recommended "Integration of vocational education programmes into mainstream education in a phased manner, including beginning with vocational exposure at early ages in middle and secondary school" Further NEP 2020 also recommended that every child will learn at least one vocation and is exposed to several more. This would lead to emphasize the dignity of labour and importance of various vocations involving Indian arts and artisanship.

To integrate skills in education in KVs, KVS has already introduced Artificial Intelligence (AI) as a Skill Course/Subject in all KVs which was communicated vide KVS (HQs) letter of even number dated 16.06.2020 & 05.03.2021 for classes VIII to X. To further strengthen skill education in KVs it has been decided that the following Skill Modules and Courses (Subjects) should be offered in KVs from the current Academic Year, 2024-25 in all KVs:-

**For Classes VI to VIII: -**

For effective implementation of skill education in KVs, following instructions may be given to Principals of KVs under the Region: -

1. Only one Skill Module/Subject in each class is to be opted by all students of Class VI to XI in current session and for class XII for next session, if it is offered by KVs. It is further clarify that students of one class of same KV should not opt different skill modules/subjects.
2. The parents and students should be sensitized about the future of Skill Modules/Subjects and encourage the students to opt the skill Module/Subject as per their interest. In this regard orientation session may be organized by inviting the skill experts.
3. PGT (CS, Biology, Economics, Geography), TGT (Science, Maths), TGT WE and Librarian are preferably be trained to teach Skill Module/Subjects for class VI to XI students. In case, KV has no regular teachers in the said subject, Principal has to decide about subject teacher to be trained so that skill education is given due care.
4. Class IX & XI students are to be encouraged to opt for Skill subject as an additional subject. In addition, apart from the above skill courses listed, if any other skill course offered by CBSE may be opted by the students, if they are interested to opt.
5. Content of Skill Modules available on CBSE Academic website shall be used by students and teachers.
6. Periods assigned for WE/ Art/Comp. may be allotted for skill education as per the provisions made vide KVS (HQ) letter no. 110362/01/2018-19/KVS (HQ)/ SP/ Time-Table dated: 13.08.2018 (For classes VI - VIII, the module is of 12 hrs, so a block of 2 periods fortnightly will be enough) and four periods (2theories + 2 practical) for classes IX to XII.
7. In case of Classes IX, X & XI, if more than 15 students opt any skill subject as an additional skill subject, the arrangement of contractual teacher can be made to teach them as per the provisions made vide KVS (HQ) letter F. 11016/01/2013-15/KVS (HQ)/Acad/ASC/ATR dated 21.01.2015. Further, in case of shortage of funds at school level, request may be made to Regional Office for release of funds. In case, Regional Office is not having sufficient funds, funds may be sought from KVS HQs.
8. As CBSE has already exempted any charge for offering skill subjects, KVs may be directed to update the same in OASIS portal and same may be taken into the account at time of registration of students in Class IX & XI in the current Academic Year 2024-25.
9. The test and examinations for the skill subjects will be conducted and evaluated by the subject teacher identified by the Principal along with PT/Half-Yearly/ Session ending examination.

It is requested to take following actions at your end for effective implementation of skill course in KVs under the Region: -


1. A VC is to be conducted for all Principals immediately highlighting the importance of skill education and way forward in this regard.
2. The Assistant Commissioner of the Region looking after skill education will personally monitor the skill courses offered by KVs and provide handholding support to KVs

Accordingly, it is requested to issue necessary directions to the Principal of KVs under the Region to promote the above Skill Modules/ Subject among the students of Class VI to XI in the current academic year, 2024-25.

This issues with the approval of the competent authority of KVS.
