Madam/Sir,


With reference to the letter received from MoE Dated: 22nd September 2024, the following activities/programmes are to be conducted in each PM SHRI KVs of first and second phase in next 25 days:

- 1. Vidya Vaibhav (Olympiad)** - Organizing a school-wide Olympiad with categories like quizzes, debates, creative arts, and sports. Students will manage registration, event scheduling, judging, and awards, encouraging peer participation while developing leadership and organizational skills.
- 2. Manthan Mandal (Debate Club)** - Starting a debate club where students research and discuss current events or issues relevant to their community, with their junior peers. Topics for PM SHRI Manthan Mandal would be:
 - a) Viksit Bharat and it's contours
 - b) One Nation One Election
- 3. Digital Quest** - Students identify any issue regarding a cause or issue they care about (environment, sports) and run a social media campaign by using digital tools (computers, tablets) by taking support from the teachers.
- 4. Discover & Learn Local Sites** - Students in small groups could do a project by using old photographs, newspaper clippings, letters to understand about local sites in their locality. Students can present about these sites through creative ideas (dressing, art drawings about the site).
- 5. Field Visit** - It is an essential practical component of PM SHRI program wherein students are exposed to Agriculture Universities & institutions, Gardens, parks, Farms, Nutritional Gardens etc. It develops a sense of community and the importance of working together towards a common goal.

Hence, it is requested to the Deputy Commissioner of all Regional offices to circulate this letter to every school of your region and encourage the principals to implement the proposed activities and programmes outline herein. The aim of this activity to enhances the student engagement and foster a positive learning.
